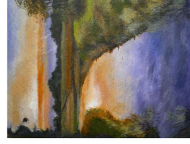
I love creating dramatic skies in my pictures, using either acrylics or pastels.

As an artist fascinated by watercolour I paint a variety of subjects, mostly landscapes, to capture atmosphere, mood and light.



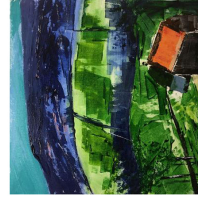
Kay Stanton

I paint in oils and acrylics, impressionistic landscapes, portraits and abstracts.



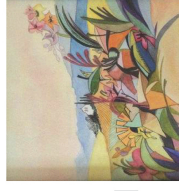
Stan Pougher

Fun art painted on reclaimed roofing tiles which can be used to brighten up an area, inside or out.



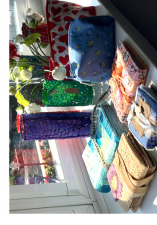
Liz Pullen
