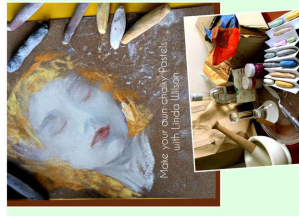

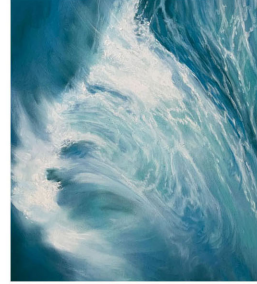

H.A.S. ARTFAIR - Hornsea Town Hall 8th & 9th August

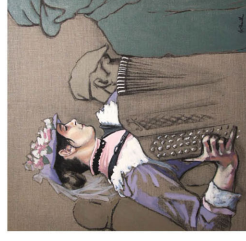
